## **Deanery Parish Share 2024**



Thank you to all Parishes who have committed amounts towards the Deanery Parish Share total for 2024 of £564,033. This is lower than last year and we know where possible some parishes may be able to give more when finances for the year become clearer. We do value our stipendiary clergy and this is one way we can support them in their busy lives.

At the time of writing this report we have not received any updates from the Diocese on the actual amount of Parish Share contributed to date for 2024.

Sally continues to keep us all up-to-date with items of concern and interest. Thank you Sally!


The method by which the Deanery Administration Function is financed is by agreement at Deanery Synod, as a small percentage of pledged Parish Share. As some of our parishes were not able to

commit their Parish Share pledges for 2024 until after the February Deanery Synod meeting, we suggested that an interim percentage of 1.6% would be used to calculate a parishes contribution towards the Deanery Office expenses. I can confirm that this percentage will be used for 2024.
